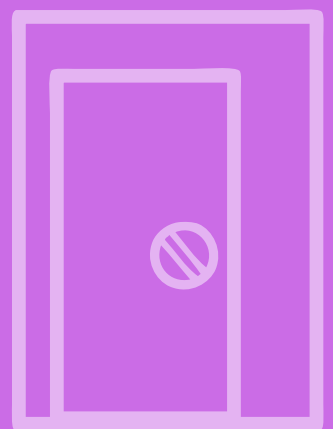


EXAM HELP
